The SCMA Sustainability Award recognizes organizations that demonstrate platform leadership by adopting strategies that make supply chain sustainability part of their corporate objectives. The objective of sustainability takes on broad meanings to operate in ways that are consistent with the highest standards for social responsibility and environmentally sound practices contributing to the development of a vibrant growing community. Objectives also include good governance and conduct; ensuring continuous improvement in support for all stakeholders; and contribution to the bottom line performance of the organization.

- A)** Continuous improvement in sustainability is part of the organization’s vision and has become an integral part of the organization’s culture. Demonstrate development and implementation of specific measurable goals and targets and implementation of tools and/or technology to monitor the effectiveness. (e.g. vision statement, corporate objectives, supporting documentation, KPI’s).
- B)** Highlight your greatest achievement(s) to date in sustainable supply chain management (provide quantifiable data).
- C)** Demonstrate how your sustainability initiatives have enhanced your organization’s bottom line (provide quantifiable data).
- D)** Identify initiatives, which have demonstrated measureable reduction in use of water and energy in your warehouse/storage facility and or use of alternative energy sources, as well the use of recycled material to operate the facility. (e.g. LEED certification, solar power).

- E)** Describe implementation of strategic sustainability initiatives with your suppliers and or customers (e.g. supplier diversity programs, sourcing recycled materials, avoidance of conflict. materials, transparency into the upstream and downstream supply chain, streamlining/optimizing supply chains, recyclable/reusable packaging components).
- F)** Social responsibilities - identify programs to foster employee satisfaction, comprehensive polices for governance and conduct, equal opportunity employment policies and the extension of such policies to suppliers and customers. (e.g. support for employees’ personal and professional development, diversity policies).
- G)** As a good corporate citizen, describe best practices in the community, support for local businesses/suppliers and your organization’s involvement in fundraising and volunteer activities.
- H)** Please include an executive summary of your submission (max. 250 words) which will be used to recommend and introduce the successful nominee, inform press releases, etc.

Nominations can include appendices such as a resume, biography, news clippings, letters of endorsement, articles of literature or copies of records/honours received, up to a maximum of an additional 20 pages.
